THE NEW MEXICO ASSOCIATION OF COMMUNITY COLLEGES (NMACC)

NMACC is an association of the nine community colleges that are branch campuses of Eastern New Mexico University, New Mexico State University, and the University of New Mexico.

These community colleges serve students and communities throughout the state of New Mexico.

Important Facts:

- The total headcount across the nine branch community colleges is **20,069**, based on the **Fall 2025 Census**, representing a **7% increase** compared to **Fall 2024**.
- *The number of **dual credit students enrolled in 2024–25** ranges from **236 to 1,217**.
- *The **total number of students served through workforce programs in FY 2025** is **1,105**, with the **number of programs offered** ranging from **2 to 18** across institutions.
- *The **number of nursing program completions in 2024–25** ranges from **0 to 54**.
- *The **number of teacher fellows completing programs** ranges from **0 to 27**.
- *The **first-time, full-time freshman retention rate from Fall 2024 to Fall 2025** ranges from **36% to 65%** across institutions.
